Conference represents a part of the Research Project HERITAGE URBANISM – *Urban and Spatial Models for Revival and Enhancement of Cultural Heritage* (HERU-2032) funded by the Croatian Science Foundation.

The Research Project *Heritage Urbanism* explores the cultural/architectural heritage that, despite official conservation and preservation efforts, is in a poor condition and state of decay, without a well-defined sustainable use and insufficiently included in town and village life. The project aims to determine spatial/urban and other criteria, methods and models for revitalization and new interventions in the immediate and surrounding cultural heritage area that could contribute to its enhancement.

Respecting the fact that many cultural and historic heritage sites are threatened, the HERU project set the following goals:

- preserving cultural heritage – as the art of inheritance or the art of creating new heritage
- acknowledging the value and potentials of urban heritage – initiator and active participant in the socio-cultural, economic and tourism growth
- enhancing the condition of the urban heritage – searching for causes and reasons for its dilapidation and opportunities for its enhancement
- establishing the conservation model and creative urban heritage use – active space involved in contemporary life
- promotion of creative possibilities of using heritage – spatial criteria, methods, models and scenarios for its improvement
- excellence of the architectural design project and the creative act of creation – an important contribution to the enhancement of heritage.

The goal is to answer the questions – how can policies, approaches, methods, theoretical models and conservation/preservation practice and enhancement of cultural heritage sites be oriented towards and included within physical, spatial and economic development, taking into account cultural and historical, spatial and environmental, as well as social traits of a specific area?
